Dear Parents/Carers,

Please ensure that you keep the office up-to-date with any changes in mobile numbers, preferred numbers and, indeed, any other changes to your child's office-held information such as changes in address and email.

Our parent and carer consultation evenings are on the 17th and 24th November this term and we really hope to see you in person. We will be asking you to complete a questionnaire about the work of the school to feed into our self-evaluation processes. Your opinions count! We often use the information given to us on these forms to improve school systems and make life easier for you and your children.

SCHOOL MEALS AND HEALTHY PACKED LUNCHES

Our school provides a daily healthy school meal and there are a variety of choices, including deli and sandwich options, for the children to choose from every day, as you will see from the current menu, on the website. Meals are free-of-charge for Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 children. Meals are only £1.50 for Key Stage 2 children, far cheaper than providing a packed lunch. Ofsted are looking closely at school dining halls, school meals and packed lunches and they will focus on healthy eating and lifestyles during their visit. I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that a packed lunch should be a healthy packed lunch and chocolate and sweets should not be included in your child's packed lunch. There will again be special promotion days for children to stay in school for lunch over the course of this year. There will be a raffle and prizes for the children! Further details will be sent out to you in due course.

It will be lovely to see all of the children back in their school uniforms. A reminder that uniform expectations are on the school website. Jumpers and cardigans with the school logo are available
