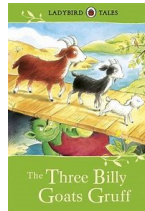
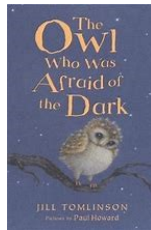
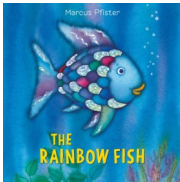


## English

## Key Stage 1

### Autumn Term 2023

## Science

As scientists we will be looking at materials and their properties. We will explore suitable materials for making different items. We will learn new vocabulary (such as transparent and opaque) and compare similarities and differences in a range of materials such as wood, metal, plastic, glass, fabric.

## History

As historians we will be investigating the life of our local hero, Amy Johnson. We will also learn about past events such as the great fire of London!



## Maths

As mathematicians we will be sorting and counting objects carefully and looking at groups of objects. We will represent these with written numbers.

We will investigate counting, number lines and 100 squares in lots of different ways, starting at different numbers, one more and one less, counting backwards.

We will compare numbers and use symbols to represent greater than, less than and equal to.

As mathematicians we will also investigate addition and subtraction within 10 and shape.

## Art & Design

As artists we are concentrating on drawing and covering line, shape, tone and colour this term. We will learn about famous artists and local artists, and use their artwork to inspire us to create our own. At the end of our unit we will hold an exhibition after school for you to come and see all of our creativity! In design technology we will be looking at the structure of windmills. We will appraise and develop our technical knowledge before designing and build our own windmills.

As friends we will all learn the Paisley Golden Rules and follow routines. In our Jigsaw lessons we will learn to think about the feelings of others and what makes us feel happy and safe.
