English

In English we will follow the Talk for Writing process to learn, explore and write different text types. This term, Mrs Inchbold's class will be studying instructions, fantasy stories and Explanation texts whilst Mr Hulland and Miss Hart's classes will be studying information texts and creating a news recount. They will also be writing a portal story as well as a set of instructions based on how to make a marsh bomb sweet.

Year 4 will be reading and analysing the texts Forces and Magnets and The Iron Man this term. Year 3 will be reading Revolting Rhymes.

Art

As artists we are studying Sculpture with clay. We will learn about ceramists Eliane Monnin and ReCheng Tsang and take inspiration from their work. We will be learning how to manipulate clay using a range of techniques to create our final piece.
