


Music

Key Stage 1



Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about plants and what they need to grow. We will be planting seeds and carrying out an investigation to observe how well the seeds grow in different environments. We are excited to see plants in our classrooms! We will also be learning about the parts of a plant and will be able to correctly name each part.

Geography

This term we will be focusing on local geography. We will be exploring the school

grounds and making maps with the aid of aerial photographs. We will also look at maps of the UK and begin to locate its countries and the amazing place we live - Hull.



Maths

In Year 2, we will continue to study multiplication and division investigating the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Children will then study place value within 20, addition and subtraction and money. There will be a large emphasis on practical learning as well as embedding skills through everyday situations and problems.

In Year 1, we will learn to add and subtract within 20 using number lines as aids. We will continue to focus on number reversals and correcting number formation. We will then continue to develop our understanding of place value aiming to confidently recognise how many tens and ones numbers to 20 are made up of.

Arts & Design

In Design Technology, we will be creating some special moving posters. In Art & Design we will be

learning to draw and paint selfportraits. We will mix different skin colours and print a background based on the artist Frida Kahlo.



RE

In RE lessons, we will be looking through the Theological lens, exploring how beliefs are expressed. Children will be introduced to key figures from Old and New Testaments alongside stories from other religious traditions.
